Are face coverings required in the workplace per N3B-AP-003, COVID- 19 Resumption of Operations, Rev. 20?

Starting August 2, all N3B employees, visitors and subcontractors (vaccinated and unvaccinated), are required to wear face coverings in all indoor areas, including vehicles, industrial trucks, work areas and while performing activities that require close contact.

Unvaccinated workers are required to wear face coverings in all outdoor areas. Fully vaccinated workers may remove face coverings in outdoor areas.

Face coverings are not required for an individual in an office with the door closed.

The Governor of New Mexico updated the public health order stating that NM is "fully open" as of July 1, 2021. How does this affect workers?

Based on decreases in statewide case rates and in COVID-19 positivity levels, N3B is relaxing most of the COVID-19 restrictions in accordance with the New Mexico governor's updated executive order, Department of Energy guidance, and CDC guidelines. However, N3B remains in compliance with President Biden's Executive order for onsite operations while continuing to utilize telework opportunities.

Note: N3B Program managers, Directors and line managers will encourage everyone to get vaccinated and to understand the controls that will continue

for unvaccinated personnel. Those controls will be relaxed following completion of the vaccination process for those who provide proof of vaccination (copy of completed vaccination card to Occ Med.)

Does the random COVID testing apply to me?

Random COVID-19 testing is being performed for workers who are not fully vaccinated and on site either full time or the majority of their time (greater than 50%). You must complete and submit an acknowledgement form. Your Supervisor will ensure that you have completed and submitted this form. If you are not scheduled to be on site that day, you do not need to come to work for the test. Let LANL know and reschedule the test. You do not need to quarantine after the random COVID test, unless a positive result is received.

What if I have been out of state on domestic or international travel?

Vaccinated individuals are exempt from the travel isolation requirements for domestic and international travel if the following are met:

- No post travel COVID-19 symptoms are experienced.
- Upon return, a daily self-check assessment is performed with satisfactory results.
- A copy of the completed vaccination card has previously been provided to N3B Occ Med (employee's manager can verify with N3B Occ Med that the employee's card is on file and employee is noted to be fully vaccinated).

All unvaccinated workers, subcontractors and visitors affiliated with N3B must abide by the listed travel restrictions in *N3B-AP-003, COVID- 19 Resumption of Operations, Rev. 19* (Page 14).
